Monitoring for NLOW

The NLOW project has been delivering small-scale habitat enhancements in green spaces and the surrounding countryside within areas close to the Old West River.

Examples include:

- New wildlife ponds
- Enhancing wildflower meadows
- Planting native mixed hedges
- Creating bug hotels and installing bat boxes
- Reprofiling farmland ditches by creating berms and scrapes

Together, these improvements will create a more resilient landscape in the Cambridgeshire Fens; connecting dispersed species and habitats, while creating demonstration sites for others to learn from.

Monitoring for NLOW Can you help us?

We need as many volunteers as possible to help us monitor the work started by NLOW in order to protect the habitats for future generations.

What is involved?

This is a flexible volunteering opportunity which will provide vital updates and support local wildlife into the future.

Visit a local habitat enhancement site, take a photograph (<u>video guide available here</u>), note any changes (since your previous visit) and record any wildlife you encounter on your visit.

How often do I need to visit?

Visit as often as you like - the sites are for the benefit and enjoyment of wildlife and the local community!

We recommend visiting the site once every 3 months to carry out the monitoring activities. This will provide seasonal updates and allow time for noticeable changes to occur between each visit.


