

## A guide for Nature Volunteers

## Chose a route

Plan a walk which you enjoy, that is suitable during all seasons and you can follow regularly (e.g. every 3 months).

It **can** be outside of the NLOW project area.

1.WHAT?

Only record the species you can identify during your walk.

Use ID books, apps and our <u>NLOW ID</u> <u>guides</u> for support. Take a photograph if you can for later identification.

3. WHEN?

The date of sighting [dd/mm/yyyy]

## **SUBMITTING**

Submit your record sheets regularly on the <u>NLOW</u> website or via email to the team. Your records will be added to the <u>CPERC</u> database.

## Recording wildlife

When you walk your route, record the wildlife you see (e.g. blackbird, comma butterfly, lapwing) making note of the 4Ws.

2. WHERE?

Make a note of the location where you saw the species (include at least a 6 figure grid reference or What3Words location)

4. WHO?

Your first and last name.

Optional to include.
For example, were there any
juveniles? Were they on a nest?
